1) Sailing

Making the most of our close proximity to the water, sailing is back and with the addition to our fleet of eight brand new Optimist dinghies we are now offering sailing from Grade 3 and above! The location of Ohana's beach club is just a few minutes bus trip from campus and an ideal setting at Pasir Ris Park for water activities. Students will learn nautical terminology, weather forecasting, the points of sail, how to rig up, launching and recovery and how to sail around various on water courses. There is a strong teamwork and cooperation element and students will develop resilience and responsibility as well as a sense of community spirit.

2) Paddle Sports



This mixed paddling sports course gives the flexibility to learn Stand up Paddle boarding (SUP) on flat water days and Kayaking when the weather is less tame. The interchangeable skills learned between the two disciplines open up unique opportunities to explore Singapore's coastline and network of canals and waterways. With a heavy emphasis on individual and group safety, students will develop personal responsibility and leadership. The course is conducted at Ohana's beach club, an idyllic spot at the end of Pasir Ris Park.
