The email will contain a document outlining the process for remark and retake requests. Students should read this before making inquiries about IB DP results, transcript requests, examination re-marking, or re-taking IB DP examinations.

The UKMT Hamilton and Maclaurin Mathematical Olympiads are prestigious follow-on rounds of the UKMT Intermediate Mathematics competition. Only 1600 students globally qualify to sit these Olympiads. This year we had four OFS students who qualified. The esteemed four took on the 2 hour challenge, with 6

Olympiad style questions, on Friday, 22 March 2024. We are pleased to announce this year's outstanding results.

Grade 9 student, HAHM Seojoon, received a Merit award in the Hamilton Olympiad.

Grade 10 students GARG Arush and TAKAHASHI Ryosuke received Distinction award in the Maclaurin Olympiad.


Grade 10 student, NOH Hyeonggyun, received a Distinction award, as well as a Silver Medal for scoring in the top 50 students globally.

Tordera River. Here, students meticulously collected and analysed primary data, including measurements

such as depth, width, velocity, gradient, and bedload size. This fieldwork will serve as the foundation for the students' IB DP internal assessment.

In addition to our river study, students delved into the complexities of urban environments through a case study on urban deprivation in El Raval, a neighbourhood in Barcelona. By immersing themselves in the community, students developed a nuanced understanding of the socio-economic challenges faced by marginalised urban populations and the interconnected factors contributing to urban inequality.

As we reflect on our time in Barcelona, we are immensely proud of our students. Their open-mindedness has enabled them to bridge classroom learning with real-life examples through firsthand experiences. Their dedication to learning (a lot of evenings spent in the classroom at our hotel), along with the support of our committed staff (Mr. Hepburn and Ms. Banerjee),

has made this trip a truly transformative experience.

Cambodia Outreach Club

In the rural areas of Cambodia, subsistence farming remains a way of life, and most children have to work in the farms instead of going to schools. The Cambodia Outreach Club is working together with a Cambodian charity called ODA (Opportunities of Development thru Art), responsible for preparing underprivileged children for well-paying careers in the tourism industry by teaching them the English language, as well as computer literacy and foundational subjects.

The Cambodia Outreach Club is responsible for producing teaching aids, which are graciously donated to various ODA schools every year by the Cambodia expedition team. Just this semester, the club's fiercely loyal members worked on laminated alphabet cards to replace our allies' ageing equipment. The members have also been responsible for examining donated educational board games before sendoff, and for the repairs of some constructor kits for the use of teaching STEM subjects.

One of the club's loyal members is currently set to visit Cambodia after semester examinations, and will be one of the lucky few responsible for donating the club's equipment to some of the ODA schools. For two semesters, the club has also been staffed by numerous members of previous Cambodia expeditions, who have been applying their expertise at every turn.

Other than the alphabet cards, board games and constructor kits which have been made this semester, the 2024 expedition to Cambodia will also be responsible for donating the flashcards and sock puppets, which the club made last semester.

The members of the Cambodia Outreach Club are always ready for the opportunity to do such important work, and deeply proud of contributing to the economic and societal development of Cambodia.

Battle of the Bands 2024


On Wednesday, March 27, 2024, we hosted the Battle of the Bands 2024, and the night was a blast! There was such a diversity of songs from different genres, and

OFS Tigers

In only our second year of competing in the Athletic Conference of Singapore International Schools (ACSIS), the OFS Tigers have begun to establish themselves as one the most formidable international schools participating in competitive sports.

We have endeavoured to provide more quality opportunities for training and competing to our OFS community through successfully doubling the number of teams across a range of sports and age groups who competed in ACSIS, making competitive sport more accessible and inclusive.

We also built in new and additional sports to our program, offering Volleyball, Table Tennis and Chess all of which have been remarkably successful.

OFS has quickly risen not only through the ACSIS divisions, but also with many sports at the national level where we have finished on the podium achieving over a combined 350 gold, silver and bronze medals.

Furthermore the OFS Tigers competitive sports program has developed three National Champions. Two Singapore National

Swimming Champions and one Singapore National Gymnastics Champion as well as multiple National gold, silver and bronze medalists. OFS is also represented in Cricket and Swimming on the Singapore National Team and have swimmers competing abroad in Holland and Canada who are set to be selected to represent their national teams and have qualified for the World Cup to be held in October later this year.
